

Course Description

This course teaches participants how to confidently respond to an emergency in the home or workplace and provide lifesaving care until professional help arrives. This course meets the requirements for workplace training where there are six or more workers on any one shift. Training includes practical skill stations, scenarios and written evaluation.
