

Industrial First Aid Responder Course

Course Description

This course will focus on the potential serious and life-threatening hazards in the workplace and how to respond confidently in this environment. This customized course will teach skills and techniques for sustaining life, preventing further injuries, and caring for illnesses and injuries until the next level of medical personnel arrives.

Training includes practical skill stations, scenarios, and written evaluation.

Approved by WSIB and provincial workers' compensation boards.

24 Hours in-class (3 Days)
